Business Manager, Ryan Marchant, offers information and explination pertinent to FFCHS financials.

Revenues

- July- June more than approved budget.
- Included in total, restricted Sped revenues of \$157,173 of which has a seperate SPED budget, allocating those funds directly to support for SPED students. See SPED financials.
- FY 18 FFCHS has received approx. \$144,000 over FY 17. See P&L previous year comparison.
- Thus far FFCHS has received all of its funds. Total federal funding for FY 18 was \$85,957.

Expenses

- Expenses for July- June 18 were \$2,380,041 vs a budgeted expense of \$2,316,256.
- Board previously approved the updated FY 18 budget in the last board meeting, June 5, 2018. The budget has been updated to reflect new budget numbers.
- Majority short fall is related to increse in wages and benefits.
