Fast Forward Parents and Guardians,

Governor Herbert announced late Monday afternoon that all K-12 public schools in Utah will extend school dismissals until May 1st.

As we move forward, continued cooperation and communication will be essential. We encourage students and parents to reach out to their teacher or school office with questions or concerns. Fast Forward meal services will continue for students or families to pick up from 10 am to noon each day. Emailing the Fast Forward Online Support contact ([onlinesupport@ffchs.org](mailto:onlinesupport@ffchs.org)) will continue as the primary source of contact and support outside of contacting your student's teacher directly. If your student is still in need of a Chromebook please email online support to arrange a pick up time.

We also encourage parents and guardians to remind your students to check their emails at least twice a day in order to stay on top of their homework. During the next six weeks, your students learning is critical. While next week is Spring Break (March 30-April 3), the remaining weeks your students are expected to be participating in the online learning. End of term is quickly approaching (April 16<sup>th</sup>) and we will be transitioning into Term 6 classes. As we get closer to that event more information will come.

During this time away from school, please encourage your students to maintain healthy and hygienic practices. Make sure your students are washing and bathing on a regular basis and that clothing is properly washed and cared for.
