We are excited to announce that students will be able to return to in-person learning at the start of Term 4 on Thursday January 14th.

We acknowledge that this time spent at home learning has been challenging for many and far less than ideal; however, due to this transition to remote learning during the holiday season, Fast Forward Charter High School's case count for COVID-19 is currently **0 infected students**.

As we continue through the winter months, it is incredibly important to continue practicing all the guidelines that have been put in place to keep everyone safe: social distancing of 6 feet, wearing of masks over the nose, remaining home if your student is feeling or showing any symptoms of COVID-19, and routinely cleaning surfaces and washing hands. Please remind your student that there are no hall passes available and they will need to use passing times to use the restroom. Students will also need to bring their own water bottle.

The teachers and staff are dedicated to creating a school environment that is safe for all students to learn in. We will continue with our split AM and PM schedule for the remainder of the school year with classes run Monday through Thursday and Friday's set aside for project work and make up work.

We are all excited to return to in-person learning next week and we would like to express the importance of your students attending and passing their classes. It is **critical** for them to be at Fast Forward when they are healthy to continue earning credit towards graduation. If your student was participating in class online prior to the school's transition to remote learning, then your student will remain online as they were before.

As a final reminder, there are four days left in Term 3 and students need to be attending their Zoom classes. Tomorrow, Friday January 8th, the school is also open for students to come in by appointment to receive help in their classes.
